



2019 WAHS Distinguished Alumni Award Nomination Form

Williamsport Area High School has produced many outstanding graduates who have made great achievements. Each year, to recognize those individuals, living or deceased, the Williamsport Area School District Education Foundation's presents DISTINGUISHED ALUMNI AWARDS.

This year's awardees will be officially inducted into the new *Distinguished Alumni Wall of Fame* upon receiving their awards **during the Education Foundation's first annual Donor Appreciation Event and Awards Ceremony on Thursday, September 19, 2019**, in downtown Williamsport.

DEADLINE: The following nomination materials must be received **on or by Friday, May 31, 2019**. All items must be included for consideration.

- A completed nomination form and the candidate's resume or vita.
- Must provide evidence to support any philanthropy, community service, accomplishments, awards and distinctions (professional or otherwise), and military and public safety involvement.
- Must provide at least one letter of endorsement and any material to support reasoning.
- Must provide most recent headshot or photo of candidate.

All submissions must satisfy the criteria listed above or submissions will not be considered. There are **four award categories** in which nominees can be entered:

Outstanding Young Alumnus Award: Given to an alumnus who has graduated 15 years ago or less. This award recognizes outstanding service and accomplishments of an exceptional alumnus of Williamsport Area High School. Areas of service may include but limited to professional, personal, and civic.

Distinguished Alumni Service Award: Given to an alumnus who has provided outstanding service to his/her profession, community, and/or Williamsport Area School District. This may include but not limited to work focused on improving a career area and/or leadership within community organizations.

Distinguished Alumni Achievement Award: Given to an alumnus who has modeled and employed a focus on achievement within his/her profession. This may include but not limited to improving a field of work as well as inspiring others to improve by being a role model for continuous learning.

Distinguished Alumni Humanitarian Award: Given to an alumnus who has provided extraordinary service for the benefit of others. This may include but not limited to work focused on schools, community development, and/or creating a sustainable future.

PLEASE NOTE: Additional material, including books, newspaper articles, etc., which cannot be easily copied for the Selection Committee, should not be submitted. Submitted nominations will be held for up to three years for consideration.

A panel of judges will evaluate each nomination and the award winner(s) will be announced on Friday, June 28, 2019.
